

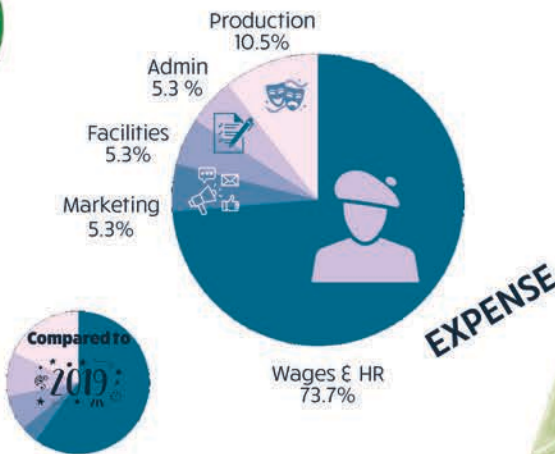
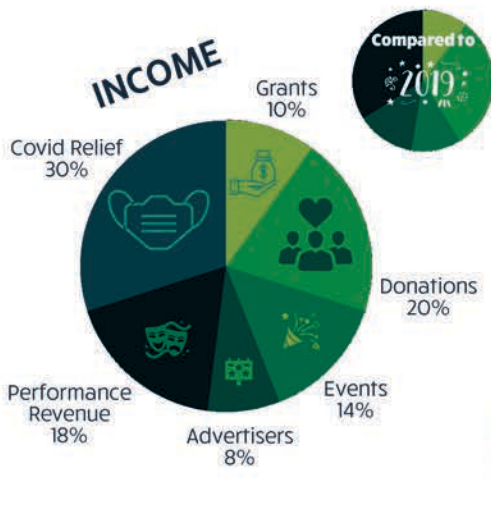

Highlights:

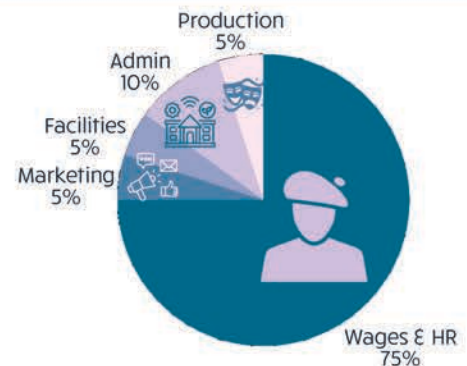
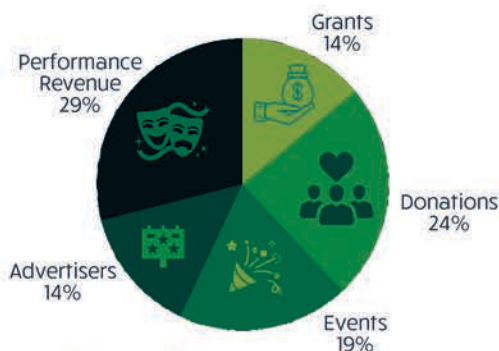
- First full Repertory Season since 2019
